



## **POINTS OF DISCUSSION FOR AGENCIES VISITING WITH STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES:**

The following information is often requested when students approach an agency at a Transition Fair or host an agency representative as a classroom speaker. Please keep these points in mind and be prepared to answer, along with other information about your agency, if you are attending a fair or speaking to a class. Remember, these are just some of the potential topics that can be discussed:

- programs and services are offered by your agency
- types of disabilities served by your agency
- determination of eligibility
- tours of your agency's facility, if applicable
  
- cost for your program (if applicable), availability of financial assistance and contact
- waiting list if applicable
- appropriate contact information at different points of inquiry/application
- age requirements
- duration of services
- goal of your agency (to provide training, job placement, etc.)
- success stories of previously served students
- assistance with application process
- availability of transportation services
