## Service-Learning Activities

- 1. Write cards to members of the armed forces who have been deployed
- 2. Help with fundraising events for local charities (examples: set up/clean up for events, provide music with band, work booths at events)
- 3. Engage with the elderly at local nursing homes for a variety of activities (examples: help with an arts and crafts project, shop for needed items and deliver, read their mail to them, write letters for them, engage in conversations, send Valentine boxes)
- 4. Ask for food donations from school families and prepare meal kits to be distributed to those in need during the holidays
- 5. Check with non-profits that house caregivers of hospital patients and ask if they have needs
- 6. Clean up a local stream, park or pond
- 7. Plan and/or plant a low-maintenance garden on school grounds or other public areas
- 8. Hold a recycling contest in an effort to increase recycling at the school or in the community
- 9. Make and distribute "I Care" Kits for the homeless shelters in the area
- 10. Fill backpacks for the backpack program at your school
- 11. School clothing closet or school store
- 12. Participate in projects such as Make-A-Wish to collect money; Serve as bell ringers at Christmas
- 13. Work at ballgames in the concession stand (stocking candy, filling popcorn bags)
- 14. Provide light janitorial duties at public daycares/churches/ballgames
- 15. Volunteer at the local library
- 16. Volunteer at local animal shelters/collect items of need for animal shelters
- 17. Volunteer with Wreaths Across America to help with wreath laying/pick up at places like the National Cemeteries
- 18. Serve at a local food pantry
- 19. Do low labor yard work for the elderly or for persons with disabilities in your community
- 20. Provide babysitting services at after-hours school events
