What is **TEP**?

Transition Employment Project

The Arkansas Transition
Project (ATP) and the Arkansas
Career Training Institute
(ACTI) developed the Transition
Employment Program (TEP), a
comprehensive program designed
to assist high school students with
disabilities that have completed
the 11th grade in discovering their
skills, abilities, interests, strengths,
and career goals through extensive
assessments, job readiness skills,
and an introduction to the world of
work

TEP is a four-week comprehensive pre-employment transition service held on the ACTI campus. This comprehensive pre-employment training service provides Arkansas high school students with disabilities that are completing the 11th grade:

- Job Exploration Counseling
- Work Based learning opportunities
- Counseling on Post Secondary Opportunities
- Instruction in Self Advocacy



TEP provides unique opportunities for participants to gain employability skills.

Special Features of TEP Include:

- Assessments/Evaluations: Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, Psychological, Skills & Abilities, Pre & Post Employability Assessments
- Work-based Learning Experiences: Three on-the-job training sites
- OSHA: Occupational Safety & Health Administration general certification training – gaining potential for increased future earnings
- **4.** Opportunity to pursue additional career certifications (e.g., Customer Services)
- 5. Job Exploration Counseling & Self-Advocacy
- 6. Work-Place Readiness Training
- 7. Post-Secondary Education Counseling
